# FRIENDS OF THE WORLD CUP OF WRESTLING SOCIETY ("FWCWS")

Notes to Financial Statements - May 31, 2020

## 1. Nature of Business

Friends of the World Cup of Wrestling Society ("FWCWS") is a registered society under the Alberta Societies Act, incorporated on July 11, 1990, and subsequently revived on January 17, 2006, under corporate access 504252560. The mission of the FWCWS is to host major National and International events, to initiate and nurture permanent "infrastructure" and "endowments" that support amateur wrestling in the Alberta Capital region.

## 2. Significant Accounting Policies

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with generally used accounting principles within a framework of the accounting policies summarized below.

- Revenue Recognition Revenue, including donations, grants and gaming receipts are recognized when funds are reasonably assured to be received.
- Property & Equipment Property and Plant is generally acquired for a single event purpose, and while it remains the
  property of the society, it is expensed in full at the time of acquisition.
- Foreign Currency All foreign transactions are converted into Canadian currency at the same rate as assessed by the Bank.

#### 3. GST

FWCWS file their GST return in accordance with standard requirements.

### 4. Income Tax

As a non-profit registered society, FWCWS income is not taxable entity however FWCWS are still required to file an annual return in accordance with standard requirements.

# 5. Funds held in trust for Alberta Gaming & Liquor Commissions ("AGLC")

FWCWS is a beneficiary of gaming monies with such monies being held in trust pending their authorized use for approved purposes. AGLC policy requires funds be used within 2 years of receipt. FWCWS has no outstanding commitments. During the fiscal year, the Gaming Account borrowed \$80,000 from the General Account, which will be repaid in the next fiscal year.

#### 6. Liability Insurance

FWCWS maintains Directors' and Officers' Liability Insurance. The current policy expires November 9, 2020.

## 7. Commitments

In 2019, FWCWS committed to match up to \$5,000 in donations from Golden Bear and Pandas alumni to the University of Alberta Wrestling Athletic Scholarship Endowment Fund. FWCWS has fully paid this commitment.

## 8. Endowments & Scholarship Funds

FWCWS have and continue to make donations to various endowment funds that support amateur wrestling in the Capital region. FWCWS has made donations to the following funds:

- University of Alberta Wrestling Coaching Endowment Fund
  - O Donations made this year: \$0 Accumulated Donations from FWCWS: \$129,000 As at March 31, 2020, the fund has a book value of \$302,208 (2019 \$302,133) and a market value of \$335,935 (2019 \$391,304) after a spending allocation of \$14,319 (2019 \$10,465). The 2020-21 spending allocation is \$14,809.
- University of Alberta Wrestling Athletic Scholarship Endowment Fund
  - $\circ$  Donations made this year: \$5,000 Accumulated Donations from FWCWS: \$105,000 As at March 31, 2020, the fund has a book value of 132,628 (2019 \$122,014) and a market value of \$134,099 (2019 \$145,567) after a spending allocation of \$5,327 (2019 \$4,500). The 2020-21 spending allocation is \$5,912.
- University of Alberta Wrestling Athletic Scholarship Fund
  - o Donations made this year: \$0

Accumulated Donations from FWCWS: \$100,000

### 9. Impact of Covid-19

Covid-19 had a significant impact on FWCWS with the cancellation of the 2020 Pan-Am Qualifications event in Ottawa (non-refundable airfare of \$1,750) and the 2020 U17-U19 Canadian Championships in Edmonton, where FWCWS incurred \$30,189 in refundable, \$1,843 in non-refundable and \$95,882 in re-useable (for 2021 U17-U19 Championships) expenditures.
